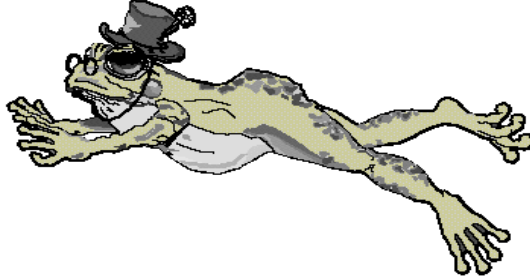

She tried to dance but she didn't know how...

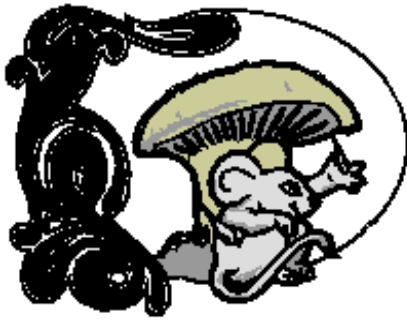
